Q&A Session

- 1. Could you please explain having coaches separated into the spectator area, away from their archers competing in a national collegiate event?
 - a. USA Archery has this restriction in place in order to follow local and state gov't COVID19 restrictions.
 - b. If the COVID19 restriction are lifted a USA Archery SafeSport Training and Background Screening will be required for all coaches who have access to the field of play, if applicable.
- 2. When will we submit Academic All-American Awards?
 - a. USA Archery will finalize these results after the Indoor Nationals results are finalized.
- 3. Can collegiate coaches use Access Med Lab for PCR COVID testing with less than a 24 hours results turnaround time. Could this be an option for coaches who want access to the field of play?
 - a. COVID19 Testing is not required for this event.
- 4. Could athlete's sub for coaches during team rounds?
 - a. Yes, this will be permitted.

<u>Other</u>

- USA Archery CEO, Rod Menzer, encouraged clubs to apply for grants and to also think about succession planning so that their clubs can continue long-term.



USA Archery has significant efforts in place to combat the negative impact COVID-19 has had on collegiate participation and bounce back larger than before. These efforts include:


- Membership Reactivation

MEMBERSHIP REACTIVATION



- Approximately 45 programs did not renew memberships between January 2020 and May 2021
- Communication plan to reactivate programs whose memberships lapsed during COVID-19
- Assist new program leaders with administrative items such as new points of contact, club membership dues, individual membership dues and Collegiate Eligibility



COLLEGIATE PROGRAM GRANTS

- 2021 Collegiate Archery Program Grant
- Equipment, Travel, Coach Certification
- USA Archery and Easton Foundations awarded \$15,338.67 and 4 Equipment Kits to 12 schools
 - USA Archery and Easton Foundations are working to possibly offer a Fall 2021 grant application for programs that were restricted from participating in Spring grant program due to COVID-19. This would be a one-time exception.





COLLEGIATE COACH AND JUDGE GRANTS



- USA Archery is offering multiple grant opportunities for collegiate coaches and student-coaches this year. Even if your program is on COVID-19 restrictions, you can apply for these grants to continue engaging in the sport and the program.
- New for 2021, USA Archery is excited to announce student-athletes and student-coaches who are interested in pursuing coaching/judging archery after college may also apply for these opportunities. Students who are the current coach of a collegiate club and are interested in pursuing coaching long-term may apply for these grants too.
- Grant opportunities will include:
 - USA Archery Level 1 and Level 2 Online Judge Course Grant
 - USA Archery Virtual Level 3NTS Course Grant
 - USA Archery Level 4NTS Course Grant
 - USA Archery Virtual Symposium Grant


CONFERENCE GRANT INITIATIVE









EVENT REGISTRATION AND EVENT RULES

- Key Reminders
 - Collegiate Event Rules: <u>www.usarchery.org</u> (Participate-Collegiate Archery Program-Event Rules)
 - Equipment Rules, Classes, etc.
 - Indoor Nationals Age Classes
 - Junior: Up to and through the calendar year of the archer's 20th birthday
 - Senior: 21 and over
 - Archers may shoot up
 - The reason for this is so collegiate archers can be put in the appropriate class to determine national rankings and for overall Indoor Nationals results





MINOR ATHLETE ABUSE PREVENTION POLICIES (MAAPP)



- An updated MAAPP, featuring new and revised policies, will go into effect on January 1, 2022
- Free trainings focused on the successful implementation of the 2022 MAAPP can be accessed at <u>www.uscenterforsafesport.org/maapp</u>
 - Coaches, parents, adult athletes, and administrators
- Coaches should familiarize themselves with all aspects of the MAAPP including specifically, electronic communications and one-on-one interactions as it relates to recruitment of high school athletes



ATHLETE SAFETY UPDATES

Athlete Safety Procedures for Event Organizers

- Outline what steps event organizers must take to pre-authorize field of play access for all volunteers, media, vendors, medical personnel, athlete assistants, coaches, judges etc. (Event Personnel).
- Developed so USA Archery can comply with requirements set forth by United States Center for SafeSport and USOPC
- USA Archery developed an Event Personnel Tracking Tool to help event organizers easily track Event Personnel Requirements
- USA Archery Sanctioned Events may be audited at any time and should maintain the tracking tool for a minimum of five years to provide USA Archery upon request


