



USA ARCHERY CERTIFICATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

I understand USA Archery reserves the right to immediately revoke this certification in the event USA Archery reasonably believes the instructor, coach or judge has (i) violated any applicable provisions of the USA Archery Bylaws, policies, procedures, codes or (ii) violated any applicable federal, state and/or local law or regulation, or (ii) otherwise engaged in any conduct that is detrimental to the health, safety or welfare of archers, or any conduct that is otherwise detrimental to USA Archery and/or the sport of archery.

At the discretion of USA Archery, reported safety violations will result in instructors, coaches and/or judges being required to retake the online course for their current certification level and/or practical exam.

At the discretion of USA Archery, Level 3 National Judges who receive a performance rating of "needs improvement" for the technical aspects of judging (i.e. rule and/or safety issues) will be disallowed from applying for a national judge role for a period of one calendar year and will be required to retake the online certification course, Level 3 National Judge Practical and serve as a shadow judge at a minimum of one event before being permitted to re-apply for and serve as a national judge.

USA Archery reserves the right to require other non-certification course trainings or requirements for continuation as a certified instructor, coach or judge as needed.
